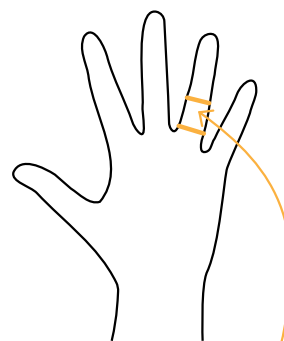


How to choose the right ring size?

By measuring the circumference of the finger

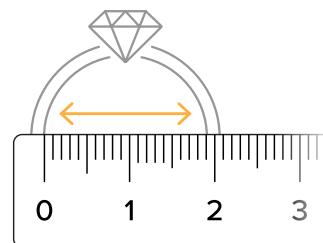
1. Prepare a measuring strip. You can use a tailor's tape measure, string or print and cut out the template from this document. It is important to print the document at a realistic, 100% size. Verify the correct size using a ruler.
2. Measure the finger twice - once at the knuckle and the second time at the place where you will wear the ring.
3. Wrap the measuring strip around your finger so that it holds firmly, but at the same time it is not too tight. Mark the point where the measuring tape crosses.
4. Choose the larger of the two values and compare it with the table below. This will give you the ideal size for your ring. If your values are between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger ring size.



Measure the finger twice - once at the knuckle and the second time at the place where you will wear the ring. Then select the ring according to the larger value.

By measuring the inner diameter of the ring

1. Take another ring's size which suits you.
2. Measure its inner diameter with a ruler, i.e. the distance between the inner edges exactly in the middle of the ring.
3. Compare the measured value with the table below. You will find the ideal size for your ring.

*In case your values are between two sizes, we recommend to choose a larger ring size.

Measuring strip:
